Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

Congratulations to our young people who received the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation yesterday with Bishop John T. Folda.

"Confirmation brings an increase and deepening of baptismal grace:

- it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation which makes us cry, "Abba! Father!".
- it unites us more firmly to Christ;
- it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us;
- it renders our bond with the Church more perfect;

- it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross" (CCC, 1303).

The reception of the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation is important in a person's formation and preparation for adulthood and discipleship. The Blessed Lord promised his disciples the extra help that would be needed to fulfill their mission, "and I will ask the Father, and he will give you another **Advocate**, to be with you forever (Jn 14:16).

The Spirit of truth is very important today as our society becomes increasingly secular and void of the practices and the living of the faith as established by our Lord when he told the Apostles, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you" (Mt. 28:19-20a).




The Knights of Columbus will be serving breakfast following the Sunday Masses on April 21. Everyone is invited to come downstairs for a hot breakfast and fellowship.


