Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday. It is a day of immense joy and thankful praise!

There will be an hour of prayer at 3:00 pm this afternoon at Little Flower Church. Everyone is welcome.

Our blessed Lord expressed to St. Faustina, "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. ... Let no soul fear to draw near to Me. ... It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy" (St. Faustina, *Diary*, no. 699).

A plenary indulgence can be attained on Divine Mercy Sunday "in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection of a sin, even a venial sin" by participating in prayers held in honor of Divine Mercy. To receive the indulgence, the three usual conditions need to be met of going to confession, receiving communion, and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. It is appropriate that the two sacraments be on the same day, however, the church permits them to be received up to 20 days before or after the work of the indulgence is completed. The Sacrament of Penance will be available today during the Divine Mercy hour of prayer.

A thank you to all who helped make the Sacred Triduum and Easter incredibly special.


