# Message from our Pastor

Dear Parishioners of Little Flower, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, and St. Mary's,

I am going to be out of town this week - leaving on Monday - attending my niece's wedding celebration. I have five nieces and nephews and she is the youngest and the last to be married. I will be returning on Monday, March 25<sup>th</sup>. Fr. Fred Alexander, SOLT, will be here in my place on Sunday, March 24<sup>th</sup>.

Our participation in the Diocese of Fargo Capital Campaign, "Living our Faith, Building our Future" will begin after Easter. The campaign will provide money for four projects,

- The renovation, upgrade, and the sustaining of the Maryvale Convent outside of Valley City into our Diocesan Retreat Center. The convent and grounds have been gifted to the diocese by the Sisters of Mary of the Presentation. This is a most wonderful gift of the sisters, which includes 120 acres of land to host a variety of events.
- The construction of an eight-room apartment complex in Fargo for retired priests, who will in turn, pay a reasonable monthly rent. The Diocese of Bismarck has an established apartment complex in Bismarck.
- Build-up, sustain, and provide a modest increase to the priest retirement pension plan of Diocese of Fargo.
- Thirty percent of the raised parish money will be directed back to the parishes for special projects as determined by the parish.

The Diocese is asking for a sacrificial gift to be paid over a four-year period. Thank you very much for your prayerful contribution to this important campaign.




